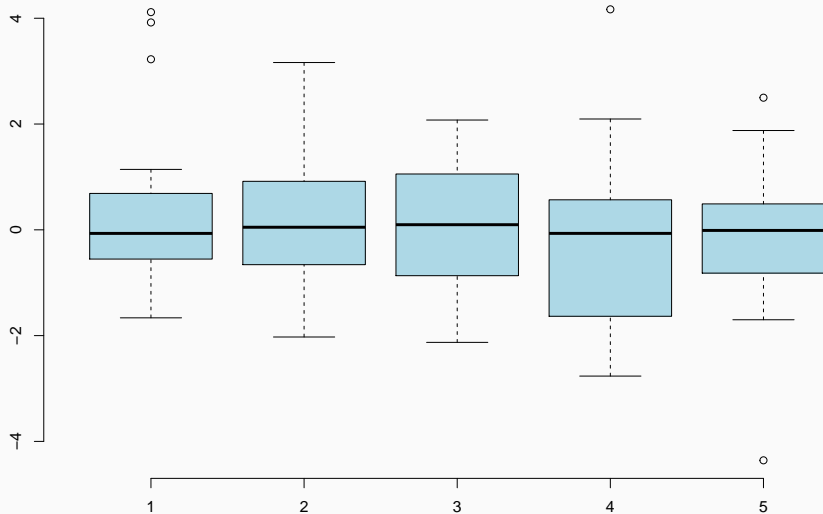
R Appendix: R Figure Example
